

Ambassador Peter Sørensen

Biography



Peter Ingemann Moesgaard Sørensen was appointed as Head of the EU Delegation to the United Nations in Geneva on 5 September 2014, and took up office on 3 November.

From 2011 to 2014 Ambassador Sørensen was the EU Special Representative in Bosnia and Herzegovina. Prior to that he held the post of Head of the EU Delegation to the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, and served as Personal Representative of the EU High Representative to the Republic of Serbia.

Ambassador Sørensen has extensive experience within the United Nations and the broader multilateral system. He held various functions in the UN Mission in Kosovo and worked as Political Adviser to the United Nations Special Envoy for the Balkans. He also served as Head of Political Affairs in the OSCE Mission to Croatia and as Legal Adviser in the Office of the High Representative in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

Peter Sørensen graduated from Aarhus University in Denmark and holds a Master degree in law. He is married and has two children.
